

VMY INTERNATIONAL

A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY...

The current model of the VMY International Team emerged in the late 90's, when Director-General agreed to create an International Council (IC) and an International Secretariat (VMYIS), where young volunteers could follow up on VMY issues and thus promote the role and the organization of the Association worldwide.



The underlining the key points are:

- Formation of a Provisional International Council, presided by Edurne Urdampilleta (1998),
- 2. Approval of the **International Statutes** (1999) and
- 3. The First VMY General Assembly (Rome-2000).



THE HISTORY CONTINUES...

During the First General Assembly, the first VMY International Council was elected and it was decided that the International Secretariat would remain in Madrid, where volunteers from different countries could share community life, serve at the VMYIS and also study during their stay in Spain.




VMYIS IN "TODAY IS THE DAY"


SEAT OF VMYIS...
